Authority:

1. PURPOSE

To implement the provisions of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision.

2. POLICY

It is the policy of the Iowa Department of Corrections (IDOC) that an Interstate Compact case may be supervised for one or more correctional agencies upon request.

3. DEFINITIONS

- A. Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision (ICAOS) - The governing commission that provides the rules and forms for Compact use.
- B. See IDOC Policy **AD-GA-16** for additional Definitions.

4. PROCEDURES

Concurrent Supervision Procedures

- A. The same policies and procedures will govern supervision of a compact case for multiple correctional agencies as applicable to only the supervising jurisdiction.

- B. A separate file must be maintained for each jurisdiction so that any special requests/reports are filed correctly and closure procedures started when pertinent.
- C. If a request for progress report is received from one jurisdiction then copies of the completed report will be sent to all jurisdictions.
- D. When one jurisdiction closes interest, then supervision will continue for the remaining agency and may require a statistical change if different than originally reported.
