Authority:

1. PURPOSE

To implement the provisions of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision.

2. POLICY

It is the policy of the Iowa Department of Corrections (IDOC) that an enrollment fee is required of Interstate parole and probation cases by the receiving state.

3. DEFINITIONS – As used in this document:

A. Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision (ICAOS) - The governing commission that provides the rules and forms for Compact use.

B. See IDOC Policy **AD-GA-16** for additional Definitions.

4. PROCEDURES

Fee Collection

- A. The enrollment fee charged to Interstate Compact clients shall be the same amount as assessed to Iowa clients. The \$300.00 fee will be collected by the supervising district.

- B. Collection of "other fees" (restitution, court costs, etc.) are addressed in IDOC Policy **ISC-06**, *Payment of Restitution or Other Costs*.
- C. No sending state shall impose a fee for the purpose of supervision on a parolee or probationer who is currently being supervised by another state under the Interstate Compact.
- D. The supervising officer will inform his/her supervisor if they become aware of a sending state requiring a supervision fee of a client.
