1. PURPOSE

To outline professional resources/references available to the health services unit.

2. POLICY

Promote first-rate patient health services by providing sufficient and current professional references for IDOC health staff.

3. DEFINITIONS - See IDOC Policy AD-GA-16 for Definitions.

4. PROCEDURES

Professional library services are an essential component of a complete patient health services program. Minimal on-site professional resources/references for each prison health services unit include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Nursing Drug Handbook renewed every two years.
- 2. Manual of Obstetrics (all facilities providing health services for women) renewed every two years.
- 3. Simplified Diet Manual by Iowa Dietetic Association current edition.
- 4. Current Nursing Reference Manual

- 5. Psychiatric Resources current edition of the <u>Diagnostic and Statistical Manual</u> of <u>Mental Disorders</u> and <u>Correctional Mental Health Manual</u>.
- 6. Appropriate Family Practice/Orthopedic/Internal Medicine resources for licensed medical practitioners.
- 7. Current <u>Tabers Cyclopedic Medical Dictionary</u>
- 8. Current Physiology and Anatomy books with pictures for educational purposes with patients.
- 9. All medical/psychological staff be allowed access to the use of the Internet for medical resources and patient information guides.
