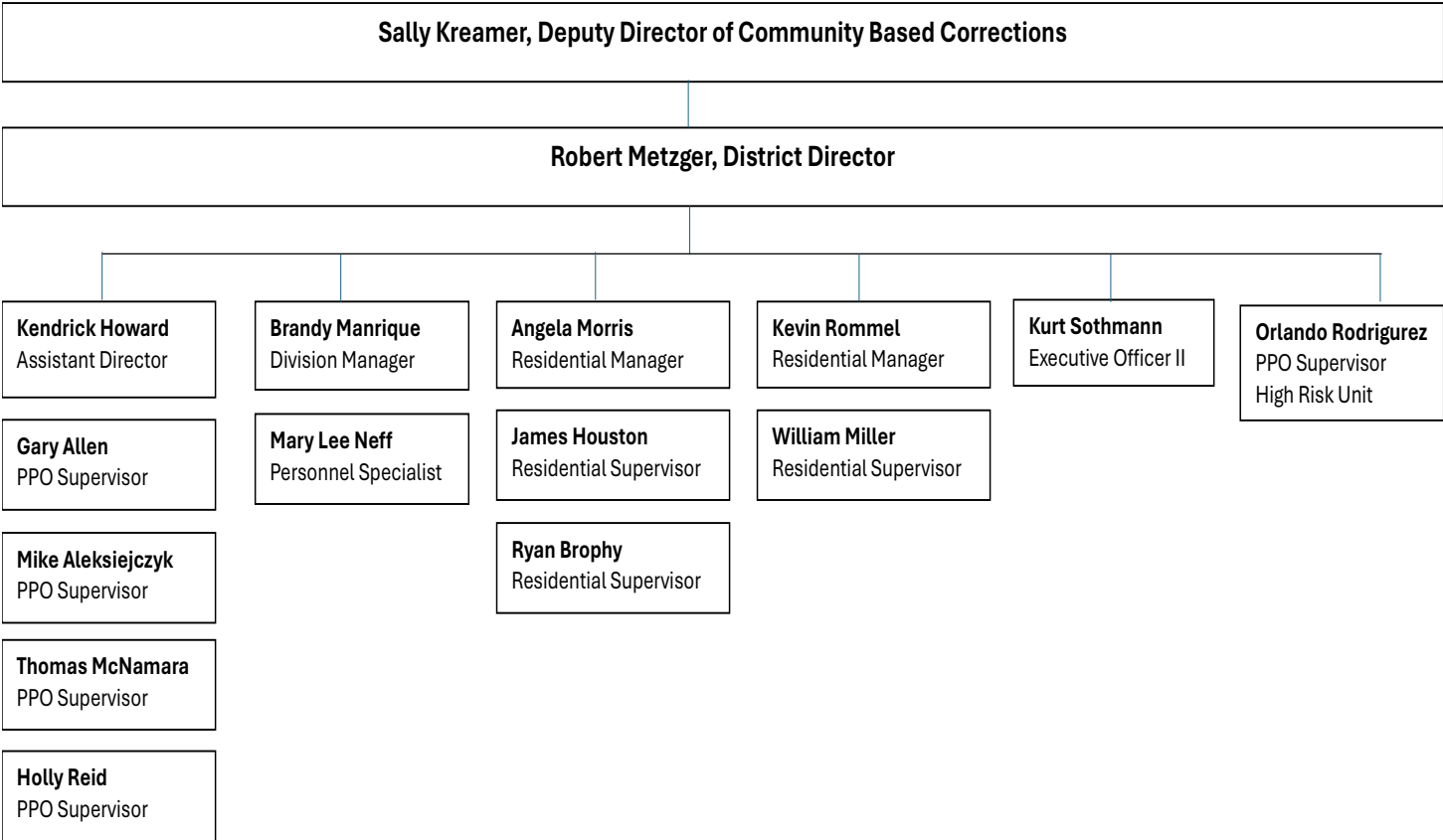
March 14, 2025
