- 2. This Data has been reviewed to assess and improve the effectiveness of the Department's sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response policies, practices, and training.
  - A. Identification of problem areas: There were no problem areas as facility cameras and staff documentation provided evidence to assist investigators.
  - B. Any corrective action taken for each facility and the Department as a whole: No corrective action taken as a result of reported incidents.
  - C. Comparison of current data to data collected in previous years: Reported incidents in calendar year 2023 remained the same from the previous year, with both reports being unsubstantiated. Having reports being made indicate residents feel safe,1 and supported in making a report and staff taking reports seriously and respond accordingly. All residential staff continue to show and display an increased awareness and reporting of sexual related incidents.
  - D. An assessment of the Department's progress in addressing sexual abuse: A two-year review indicates a strong zero tolerance stance regarding PREA related incidents, having no substantiated reports. We have completed three certified PREA audits and were found to be in full compliance. The overall progress of the District in meeting PREA standards continues to be excellent.
