## **1. PURPOSE**

To identify areas where tobacco can be used in the Iowa Department of Corrections (IDOC).

# 2. POLICY

It is the policy of the IDOC to promote a clean air environment and to protect the health and safety of staff, incarcerated individuals, and visitors. The IDOC shall restrict areas and circumstances where tobacco use is permitted.

### **3. DEFINITIONS – As used in this document:**

Smoking or using tobacco products means the carrying of or control over a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or other lighted smoking equipment, or any oral use of tobacco products. This definition includes smoking E-cigarettes or chewing non tobacco type products, such has herbal snuff.

### 4. PROCEDURES

#### A. General

- 1. The hazards of tobacco use/smoking are well established by medical and public health authorities.
  - a. The risk posed to non-smokers by passive inhalation of environmental tobacco smoke (ETS) is of particular concern.
  - b. The Surgeon General of the United States has concurred with scientific research that indicates that involuntary smoking is a cause of disease, including lung cancer, in healthy non-smokers.
- 2. The IDOC has established a goal of creating a tobacco free/smoke-free workplace and clean air environment.
- 3. Tobacco Use/Smoking is not allowed in buildings.
- 4. Staff and incarcerated individuals may not use or possess tobacco in any institution, except for tobacco/herb mix used for Native American sweat lodge and pipe ceremonies.

#### **B.** Designated Smoking Areas for Staff

Institutions will designate a smoking area on institutional premises for employee use.

#### C. State-owned Motor Vehicles

Tobacco use/Smoking is prohibited in state-owned motor vehicles.
